A. Call to order – The meeting was called to order at 6:35pm by Cindy Parkhurst.

### B. Submission of April meeting Minutes - Cindy Parkhurst

  Carol McAdam arrived prior to the start of the May Board meeting to discuss the idea further with the Board, and to go over a proposal from a law firm that she had contacted. The proposal laid out the steps taken to update the Bylaws, the time involved, and the costs.
  Much discussion ensued as Board members considered the costs, and whether it's necessary to update the Bylaws or simply add amendments. There was also a suggestion to get other bids. The Bylaws committee will continue to meet to work on a proposal to present to the Board. It was noted that any changes or additions to the Bylaws must be approved by the Board before being presented to the Co-owners for a vote.
- 2. *Handy Feller* will be here around the second week of June for tree trimming. This will include the removal of three trees which were identified as problems due to dropping messy berries, disease and/or blocking 2<sup>nd</sup> floor views, as well as the removal of three bushes.
