1. As the winter months approach, the Board would like to remind all residents of the procedures for winter weather and our parking lot:

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- The three easternmost parking spaces in front of 2445 are designated for snow storage. Should it become necessary, those spaces will be blocked and may remain so for the winter season.
- Please use your carport as much as possible. When a significant winter weather event is forecast, carport usage will be required, and residents will be asked to park any additional vehicles at the top of the hill (near the entrance), or in the northwest section of the parking lot.
 - This is to ensure that the snowplows can effectively clear the main areas of the parking lot, especially in front of both buildings.
- Please do not allow your vehicle to overhang the sidewalks! The sidewalks need to be kept clear of any obstructions for the safety of our residents, and to allow the snow maintenance crew to effectively clear the sidewalks.
- Salt buckets and shovels will be available at each entrance. As our snow maintenance crew cannot be here round the clock, we encourage residents who are able to help keep the entry areas cleared and salted.
- 2. On behalf of the Association, the Board would like to extend our heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of Roger Mauritho (unit 112), who sadly passed away on November 11.
 Roger was a beloved neighbor and friend to many and will be greatly missed.
