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E. New Business

- 1. With the winter months right around the corner, the Board would like to remind residents of the procedures when significant winter weather is expected:
 - Carports <u>must</u> be used whenever possible to allow the snowplows to do their job.
 - Extra vehicles should be parked in the northwest corner of the parking lot. If necessary, the Board may contact you to move your vehicle to an unused carport temporarily.
 - > The priority is to keep the main lot and driveway clear for the plows.
 - If you must park in front of the buildings, do not allow your vehicle to overhang the sidewalk. This will help with clearing snow from the entire sidewalk.
 - Please note that during the winter months, our designated snow storage area is the three easternmost front curb parking spaces in front of building 2445. These spaces will be blocked off as necessary and may remain so for the rest of the season.
 - Salt buckets and shovels will be available at the front entries. If you are able to help our community by throwing some salt down or shoveling, it would be much appreciated.
